The Windy City Knitting Guild is pleased to offer a weekend with **Annemor Sundbø**. She was the owner and operator of the last remaining shoddy factory in Norway from 1993 to 2006. She is a textile designer and weaving teacher as well as spinning, folk art embroidery and knitting design. She is the author of *Everyday Knitting: Treasures from a Rag Pile*, *Setesdal Sweaters: The History of the Norwegian Lice Pattern*, and *Invisible Threads in Knitting*.

Class 1 Loyesaum (Setesdal antique embroidery)

Learn to do the unique decorative embroidery that surrounds the collar and cuffs on Setesdal sweaters.

Cost of a kit for the collar is included with registration. If you would like materials to embroider the cuffs, you can request an additional kit.

Supplies: Scissors and darning needle.

Class 2 – Selbu Traditional Mittens

Sunday, March 7, 2010: 9:00 – 4:30 p.m. **6** hours

Selbu mittens are typically black and white patterned. This is an historic style and was done as a business for export within and from Norway. The patterns are integrated into the structure of the mitten. The eight-point star or rose is iconic but many other patterns are used.

A kit to make the mittens is included with registration.

Supplies: Fine double pointed needles and the usual knitting equipment.
