If you volunteer, you will receive a 5% discount on the percentage of sales deducted from your check for every 4.5 hour shift you work. For example, if you volunteer for 1 shift, you will only have to pay 5% of sales. If you volunteer for 2 shifts, then you will not have to pay a percentage of sales. You can choose not to volunteer at all.
